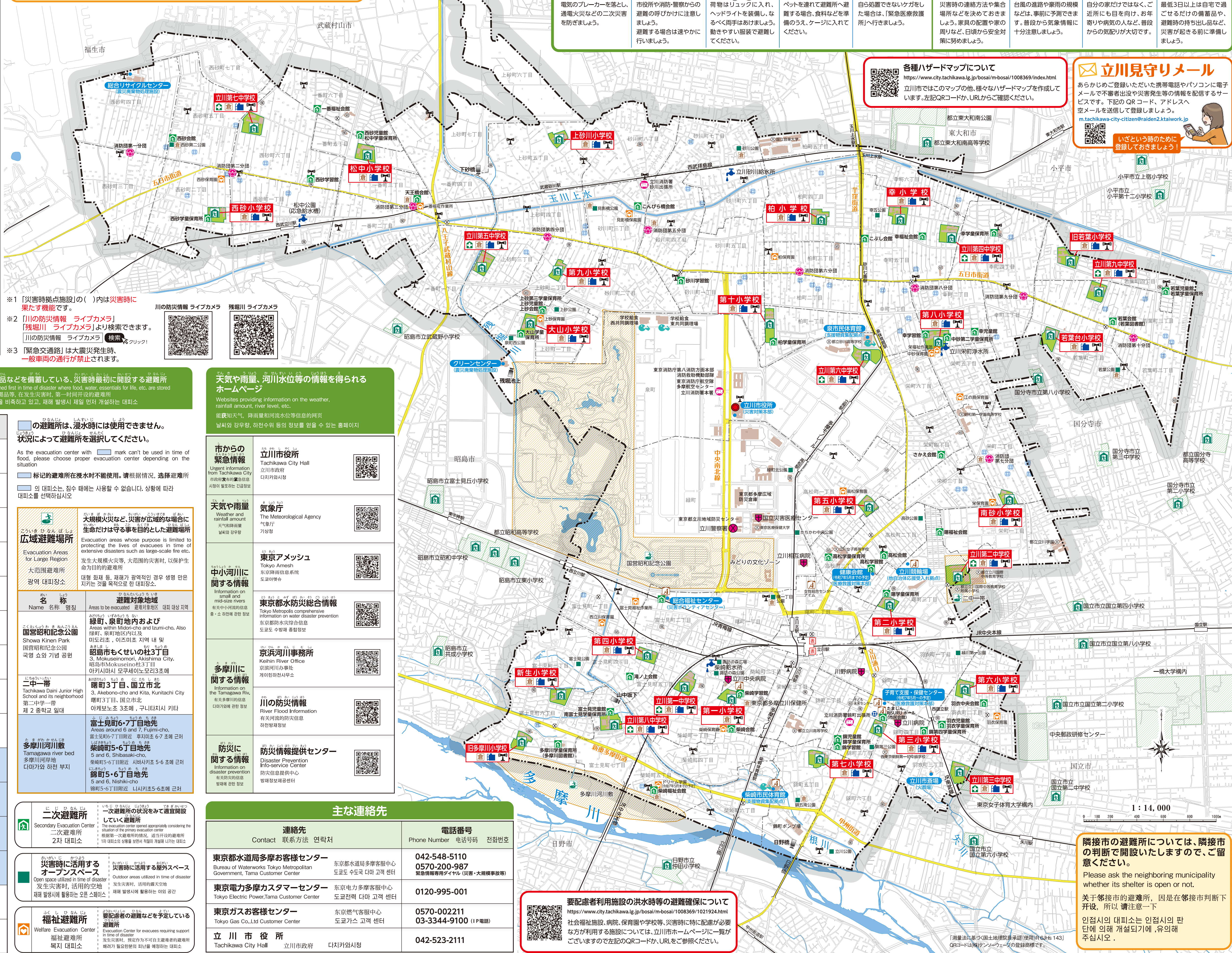

Disaster Prevention Map of Tachikawa City

この地図は、大規模地震などの自然災害が発生した場合に、住民のみなさまが自主的かつ迅速に避難するために必要な情報(避難場所等)を示したものです。



避難の心得 (Disaster Evacuation Guidelines) section with illustrations and text explaining how to evacuate safely, including instructions on what to bring and how to move.

日頃の備え (Daily Preparation) section with illustrations and text about preparing for disasters, such as having emergency supplies and knowing evacuation routes.

立川見守りメール (Tachikawa Watch Mail) section with a QR code and text about receiving disaster alerts via email.

一次避難所 (Primary Evacuation Center)

Table listing primary evacuation centers across the city, including names, addresses, and contact information.

二次避難所 (Secondary Evacuation Center)

Table listing secondary evacuation centers, which are open spaces used in case of a disaster.

市からの緊急情報 (Emergency Information from the City)

Information section providing details on how to receive emergency alerts, including weather information and disaster prevention resources.

主な連絡先 (Main Contact Information)

Table listing key contact numbers for disaster response, including the city hall and various emergency services.

隣接市の避難所 (Neighboring City Evacuation Centers)

Text explaining the importance of checking with neighboring municipalities for evacuation center status during a disaster.

要配慮者利用施設の洪水時等の避難確保について (Disaster Evacuation for Vulnerable Groups)

Information section for vulnerable groups, including QR codes and text about ensuring safe evacuation for those with disabilities or other needs.
